HOSPITALIZATION

For patients requiring stabilization because of very acute symptoms, Lindner Center of HOPE has 48 private-rooms for short-term hospital stays. The Center has expert treatment teams that care for adolescents ages 12 to 17 in collaboration with Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, and adults age 18 years and older. (513) 536-4673.

OUTPATIENT SERVICES

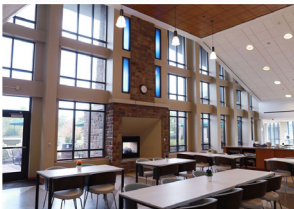

THE FARMER FAMILY NEUROMODULATION CENTER

As treatment response is individually unique, patients benefit from varied treatment options. Lindner Center of HOPE provides Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) and Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS) therapy for those who have not achieved adequate improvement from medication and counseling.
